RULES

- Participants must follow the instructions of officials as identified at the pre-event meeting to be attended by all starters.
- Crossing of all road and rail transportation right-of-ways to be done as instructed and only when deemed safe by official.
- The event will only start if the temperature is -22° C or better with no wind and is expected to be maintained or exceeded over the duration of the event.
- Skiers must pass the 1st checkpoint (Baker Creek) by 10:30 am and the 4th checkpoint (Sawback picnic area) by 2:15 pm or surrender their bib to the nearest official and discontinue participation.**
- Any skier abandoning the event must surrender their bib to the next check point official. Please respect this to avoid any unnecessary searches by race officials.
- Any skier surrendering their bib at the request of an official will no longer be considered to be participating and will not be eligible for event support. Assistance with transportation to the finish will be facilitated where necessary.
- This is a wilderness event and as such skiers must be prepared to deal with changes of weather and trail conditions, wildlife encounters (avoidance) and be prepared to render help to other participants. Face masks are encouraged for leg 1.
- This is a classic technique event with only the final leg offering enough room for skating.
